## Check List to Determine Completed Minimum Graduation Requirements

For Students enrolled in $\mathbf{9}^{\text {th }}$ grade on or after July 1, 2015.


The courses listed reflect the Washington State minimum requirement for graduation of 24 credits. Each line above represents one semester ( 75 hours) of work ( 0.50 credit).

* Math credits should include: Algebra 1 or Integrated Math 1; Geometry or Integrated Math 2; and Algebra 2 or Integrated Math 3. A student may elect to pursue a third credit of math other than Algebra 2 or Integrated Math 3 under certain circumstances.
** These credits may be replaced by Personalized Pathway Requirement.
These are Washington State minimum graduation requirements and are accepted for admission to community and junior colleges, and to many four-year institutions, although the latter may require additional core course credits.

Students who wish to attend a four-year university after high school should contact the institution(s) to determine their specific entrance requirements.
